2019 ACSPN CONFERENCE TRAVEL AND SECURITY INFORMATION

As the local organizing committee of the 6th Annual Conference of the Association of Communication Scholars and Professionals (ACSPN) look forward to welcoming you all to Abeokuta, we feel it is necessary to provide some information that would guide participants coming for the event.

TRAVEL ADVICE

1. The city of Abeokuta has no commercial airport. Hence, all participants are expected to get to the venue by road. The nearest airport to the city of Abeokuta is the Muritala Muhammed International Airport, Ikeja, Lagos
2. **For Participants Coming from Lagos State**
 - i. There are two major highways through which you can get into Abeokuta. They are the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway (via Berger) and the Lagos-Abeokuta Expressway (via Sango-Ota).
 - ii. From Local Airport Lagos or any other part of Lagos participants can board a taxi to Oshodi, Berger or Iyana Ipaja to board a bus going to Abeokuta. If the bus choose to go through the Lagos-Ibadan expressway, you will alight at Kuto Roundabout and ask for the conference venue. However, if the bus choose to go through Lagos-Abeokuta expressway (mostly for buses from Iyana-Ipaja), you may alight at Brewery Roundabout and board a taxi to the conference venue.
3. **For Participants Coming from outside Lagos**
 - i. From the axis of Ijebu-Ode-Benin-Ore through Ijebu-Ode-Sagamu expressway, connect straight to the outside right at the Sagamu interchange round about straight down to Kuto Roundabout. At Kuto, ask for the venue of the conference
 - ii. From the axis of Kwara, Osogbo, Oyo through the Lagos- Ibadan expressway, connect to the immediate right as you approach the Sagamu interchange round about on the Lagos-Ibadan express road. Then drive

straight down to Kuto Roundabout. At Kuto, ask for the venue of the conference

SECURITY ADVICE

1. At any point, always board buses at designated vehicle parks.
2. Avoid traveling at night. If coming from outside Lagos, make it a target to get to Abeokuta by 6pm at the latest.
3. Avoid taken night bus.
4. As much as possible, travel in groups
5. Do not agree to look after anyone one's possession in the bus. Change your seat if need be.
6. Avoid wearing expensive jewelries that may attract undue attention to you.
