
He is part of the researchers team on Artificial Intelligence (A.I), Ethics and Education of PUC (Pontifical Catholic University).

Is "Press Freedom" enough to guarantee a healthy media environment and the principle of the democracy?

According to a 2021 ABERT research

- 230 letal attacks against Brazilian journalists.
- Raised 21.69% comparing to 2020.
- According to FENAJ, the President himself is the main agressor at 34% of the the non-letal cases.
- "The attacks are strategic planned".
- According to RWB, Brazil is currently on the 111th position of the Global Rank, considered "red zone".

Quick View on Misinformation 2022 holds Presidential Elections

- According to AVAAZ, 7 out of 10 Brazilian citizens took "fake news" seriously during Covid-19 pandemic.
- According to DataFolha Institute, 81% of the Brazilian believes that social media needs to ban "fake news".
- Fake News Bill on Parliament is controversial
- Supreme Court is acting to regulate Social Media during elections mainly Telegram.


UNESCO and MIL




CRITICAL POINT

- Supervised Learning, Non-supervised Learning and Reinforcement Learning are other models
- Nowadays, there is A.I from chatbots and bank loans simulations to self-driving cars
- There is nothing to do with Sci-Fi, like "Blade Runner"
- There is no "singularity" or "consciousness" until now related to A.I.
